<sup>3</sup> "Section A semi-feral" refers to a particular and separately identified sub-population of pedigree-registered animals within this breed's studbook. Section A of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society's studbook lists Welsh Mountain ponies whose core registration documents, passports and entries in the National Equine Database are likely to be identified as 's' to indicate that they are semi-feral and are within the Pony Improvement Scheme for this breed.
